

We Are Not Saving Enough - In a survey conducted by Harris Interactive of 1,000 adults on personal finance many admitted that they aren't saving money for the future. 58% gave themselves an A or B on their knowledge of personal finance, 41% gave themselves a C, D or F. 57% said that they didn't have a budget, while 42% said that they had a budget and kept close track of their spending. A full 32% reported that they didn't have any savings, excluding retirement.
