

**\$1 Billion** - The amount of revenue generated by sales of Michael Jackson's work since his death a year ago, thanks in part to a new record deal with Sony Music and the most successful concert film of all time. (Source: Billboard)

**42.5 Billion** - The number of trips Americans took by foot last year, more than double the 18 billion trips taken in 1990, the first year data were available. Bike trips nearly tripled to 4 billion, from 1.7 billion in 1990. Twelve percent of all trips are now taken by foot or bike. (Source: National Biking and Walking Study)

**One-Third** - Over one-third of current homeowners say they owe more on their mortgage than their home is worth, and outlooks for the housing market in the short and long-term are growing more pessimistic. (Source: Rasmussen Reports)

**\$326/Month** - The average amount per month that parents of special needs children spend on out-of-pocket medical expenses. (Source: MetLife Center for Special Needs Planning)

**\$67/Day** - Americans reported spending an average of \$67 per day in June -- down \$5 from May 2010, but up \$6 from June 2009. Year-over-year spending is up in the Midwest and South but down in the East and West. Across the board, spending remains far below the 2008 spending range. (Source: Gallup, Inc)
