

**60%** - The percentage of surveyed Americans who believe they will get no Social Security benefits when they retire, the highest at any time since Gallup began asking this question in 1989.

**26.3 Million** - The number of hot dogs and sausages expected to be sold at major-league parks this baseball season. Boston's Fenway Park accounts for 2 million of those sales, the most of any ballpark. (Source: National Hot Dog and Sausage Council)

**2.4%** - The recovery lost momentum in the spring as growth slowed to a 2.4 percent pace, its most sluggish showing in nearly a year and too weak to drive down unemployment. (Source: msnbc.com)

**42%** - BP has replaced its CEO as fallout from the massive oil leak in the Gulf of Mexico continues, but 42% believe the government would have done a worse job responding to the leak if it had been in charge of the oil company. (Source: Rasmussen Reports)

**800** - The number of new positions Chairman Mary Schapiro said the Securities and Exchange Commission must fill to carry out the financial-reform bill's mandates. The White House has proposed boosting the SEC budget by 12%, which would allow for the hiring of only 374 additional staff members.
